About Cape Liberty Cruise Port: Cape Liberty Cruise Port is one of three trans-Atlantic passenger terminals in the Port of New York and New Jersey maritime system. It is located on the north side of a 2 mile long pier on 430 acres on a Peninsula at Bayonne Harbor. It is in close proximity to Ellis Island and the Statue of Liberty. Royal Caribbean International is the port's primary tenant. In April 2026 super cruise liner “Independence of the Seas” began operations to Bermuda. The closest airport is Liberty Newark Int’l Airport.

Statue of Liberty and Statue of Liberty Museum

For over a century, the Statue of Liberty has stood as one of the most recognizable landmarks in the world, welcoming millions with her torch held high. Located on Liberty Island in New York Harbor, she has become much more than just a statue—she is a lasting symbol of freedom.

Ellis Island and Ellis Island National Museum

Just a short distance from Liberty Island lies Ellis Island, which served as the nation's busiest immigrant inspection station from 1892 to 1954; over 12 million immigrants passed through the halls. The National Museum of Immigration preserves their stories through exhibits and artifacts, allowing visitors to explore the personal journeys that helped shape the nation's diverse identity.

Where Do I Purchase Tickets?

Tickets should be purchased through Statue City Cruises: <https://www.statuecitycruises.com/tickets>; the only ferry service that brings visitors to Liberty and Ellis Islands. All ferry tickets include access to the Statue of Liberty Museum and the Ellis Island National Museum of Immigration. Ferry Departures: Liberty State Park, 1 Audrey Zapp Dr, Jersey City, NJ 07305. To see both sites in one day, it is recommended to depart early.
