

Things To Do - Bermuda

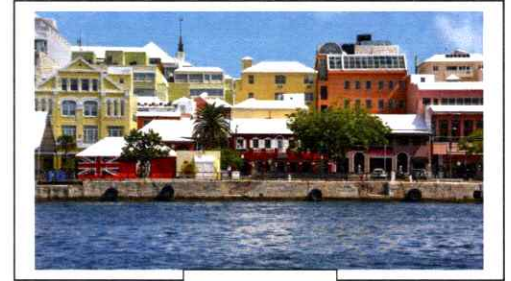

Considered an island paradise for divers and visitors. It's massive Royal Naval Dockyard complex combines modern attractions "Dolphin Quest" with maritime history at the Nat'l Museum. The island has a distinctive blend of British and American culture, which can be found in the capital, Hamilton.*

The "Bermuda Island Drive" excursion gives you an overview of the whole island in half a day. A bus will take you along the beaches to Gibbs Hill Lighthouse, where you can enjoy the 360-degree views before heading to St. George's, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and finally, the capital city of Hamilton, one of the best spots for shopping and sightseeing.

Horseshoe Bay Beach Excursion

Visit one of the island's most recognizable beaches and walk the curved, pink sand during this half-day trip to Horseshoe Bay. Meet your guide and drive and spend some time ashore. Snap a photo of your toes in the pink sand which gets its hue from coral, red foraminifera and crushed seashells. Dine at a beach-side restaurant (your cost) or rent some snorkeling gear.

Goslings Sunset Rum Tasting Cruise

Set a different pace on the Goslings Sunset Rum Tasting Cruise. Here, you'll take in the panoramas of King's Wharf at its loveliest while learning about the island's history of rum-making. You'll sample the company's line of liquor, taste rum cake and savor a Dark 'N' Stormy — Bermuda's national drink.

Bermuda Triangle Shipwreck Snorkel:

If you're on the hunt for more adventure, check out the Bermuda Triangle Shipwreck Snorkel. You'll dive and swim through two famous shipwrecks the Constellation and the Montana. Constellation is a wooden-hulled four-master; the old ships with racks of sails commonly associated with pirates. She was built in 1918 and sank in 1943. There are scattered remains of the Montana from over 150 yrs ago; her iron paddlewheel frames remain intact.

Aquarium and Crystal Caves Tour

The "Aquarium and Crystal Caves Tour" is one of the best excursions in Bermuda for families traveling with kids. While the islands' beaches get most of the glory, it's said that the most breathtaking views are here, underground. There are cave ceilings adorned with rare chandelier clusters and delicate crystallized soda straws that hang above deep, clear pools of azure blue water.
